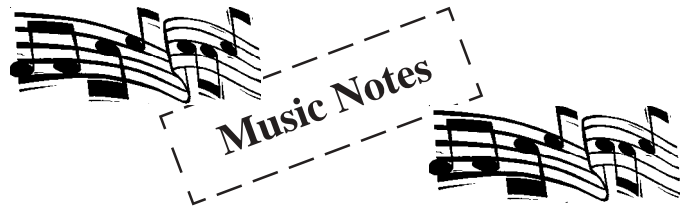


CONGREGATIONAL CARE COMMITTEE

+ Princess Sheldon, 13-year-old daughter of **Leslie Sheldon**, is back in Duke Hospital.

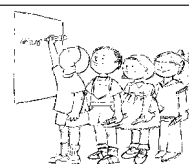
+ **Darren & Vicki Skeen** ask for prayers for Darren's parents, Molly & Bill Skeen, as Molly receives treatment for cancer.
