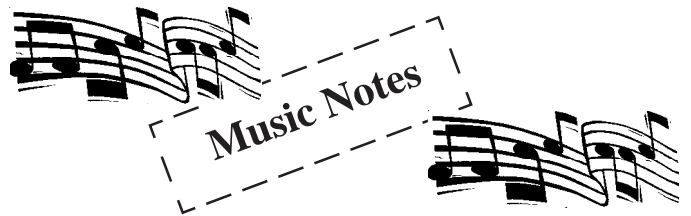

The church now has an emergency defibrillator located in the Mission Center to the left of the reception desk. This is a very simple machine to use in case of a heart emergency, and it is designed for use by bystanders. No special training is required though several of the staff have had an orientation session with Chapel Hill Deputy Fire Chief Bobby Bosworth. We are also adding more first aid supplies to the front desk and to the bus.
