We are excited to launch this name tag project along with the opening of our fall stewardship campaign. As you will see from your stewardship materials, the theme this year is "Being Transformed". Each week in October, a different message of transformation will be shared with the congregation in the form of an email video, and in worship during Sharing Our Mission. Today, the message is "Being Transformed Together." It is a message about the ways the church transforms our personal and family lives through fellowship, congregational nurture and belonging in a strong faith community. We hope these name tags will help us all be in stronger community together, and get to know each other better as members of the body of Christ.

Name tags will be available today alongside the Stewardship Packets in the courtyard after the service. We have elected to print name tags for congregants ages 2nd grade and up as it is at this age that children have graduated from nursery and Godly Play and are encouraged to be present in the worship service. We have tried our best to print name tags for everyone and with everyone's preferred name – however, we know there may be some mistakes. If your name tag needs correcting, please let the assimilation member at the table know and we will correct it and get it to you as soon as possible.

Once you have your name tag, we suggest keeping them in your glove box. This will hopefully be a place where you can easily access them for worship, committee meetings, Westminster on Wednesday events, and for times when you are in service with Westminster in the community.
